One way to do this is to bring people together by building community through funding your ideas for up to \$500! Once awarded, you have six months to complete your project. We'll stay in touch to help along the way, celebrate and report the finished project!

Who can apply? Anyone who lives, works or goes to school in Newport can apply! If you are under the age of 18, you can still apply with permission from your parent/guardian.

How to get funded? Just fill out and submit the grant! If awarded, funds have to go through a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization. Don't have one? Don't worry! ReNewport is happy act as fiscal-sponsor for you!
